OUR PROCESS

TEAM PLACEMENTS



Each athlete will receive a unique number that will be used to identify them throughout the Team Placement process. Each athlete will perform a jump sequence, dance, running, standing tumbling, and stunt. Flyers will be asked to demonstrate body positions.

If you are not able to attend the team placement for your age, you should still register and request a make up tryout date.

CALL BACKS

We will call back groups of athletes based on level and/or potential teams. We will utilize Call Backs to evaluate stunting positions, stunting knowledge/experience, tumbling in groups, and overall team and level readiness.

TEAM TESTS

Team tests will be utilized to test potential teams. We will use these sessions as a final trial to assure teams are adequately constructed and that all athletes can safely and train with a team of this level and age.

REGISTRATION

At Registration, we will assure your CEA accounts are setup and all forms are completed.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Our complete list of financial policies is listed in our Policies and Procedures Guide. Below are some general guidelines regarding how accounts are handled so that you can plan accordingly.

1

All fees are due by the dates listed within the Handbook. A \$30 late fee will be applied the day after the due date should the item be left unpaid. Late fees will reoccur monthly if a past due balance remains. Late fees are non-refundable.

The **Full Year** Programs include a commitment of 11 equal payments due on the first of the month June 2025 through and including April 2026. The **1/2 Year** program includes a commitment of 6 equal payments due on the first of the month November 2025 through and including April 2026. Each payment is an installment of the total cost of for the season.

All members are required to store a valid bank account or credit card on file through their JackRabbit account. A valid account is defined as an active bank account or credit card the processes successfully when Autopay is run. Payment Plans are available, if approved.

Product fees (uniform, practice wear, warm up, etc) are listed in the tables below, and are charged separately from monthly fees, according to the published payment schedule.

FUNDRAISING MAKES IT POSSIBLE!

We know All Star Cheerleading is an expensive sport, but we want the CEA experience to be as accessible as possible to everyone. For this reason, we offer one to two fundraisers per month, with profits being applied directly to your CEA account. Certain fundraising is required, while others are optional, but it is a great way to offset your monthly costs. Some of our families pay 50-100% of their monthly fees completely from fundraising!



This investment in your child's present and future is worth every penny, and with CEA fundraising, it is more affordable than ever before.

PROGRAM FEES

Sibling Discounts: Monthly tuition discount for siblings at 10% for the first sibling and 15% for any additional siblings.

Referral Bonuses: \$100 off monthly tuition - one time discount only, once signed handbook for referred family is received. If there is more than one referral, you will receive another discount on the following month.

Start-Up Fee – includes practice wear, gym membership and registration, practice & comp bow, t-shirt, music, and choreography.

Competition Fee – includes 6 - 8 competitions, additional expenses required for end of season events (Regional Summit, The Finale, The One, Allstar Worlds, and Worlds)

Tuition (Monthly Rate) – Includes (2-3) practice days and 1 hour tumble class per week.

Post season events are not elective and costs will be applied based on comp costs and bids earned.

Competition fees may be paid in installments. See payment plan form for details.

Discounts are based on the sole discretion of CEA Management.

Crossover Policy: (see next page for crossover fee)

- Athletes are first and foremost a rostered member of their primary team.
- Athletes must attend all practices of both their primary and secondary team.
- Crossovers do not pay additional practice tuition, but are responsible for the competition/apparel fees for each team.
- Level and division restrictions may apply.
- Crossover accounts must maintain good standing.
- Crossovers pay separately for each competition they attend; however, they only pay once for choreography/music/coaches' travel/banquet. They will pay the amount for the team with the highest fee for each.
